TEN BASIC RULES FOR SAFE RIGGING

This week we continue our months long focus on rigging safety. Below are ten steps for ensuring a safe rig.

Determine the Weight of the Load

Determine the Proper Hitch for the Load Type

Understand Angles/Tension on Slings

Select the Right Sling Based on Load Type

Select the Right Hardware for the Load

Inspect Each Sling Before You Load It

Inspect Rigging Hardware Before You Use It

Protect Slings From Cuts and Tears

Determine the Loads Center of Gravity

Pay Close Attention to Detail at Lift Time
